BAR HARBOR — Sam Shaw, owner of Shaw Jewelry in Northeast Harbor, is this year's Acadia Arts Achievement Award recipient. He will be honored by Legacy of the Arts during a special event on Sunday, June 20 from 7:30 to 9 p.m. at Agamont Park in Bar Harbor.
